Response to the Coronavirus

In response to the current crisis surrounding the Coronavirus, we acknowledge the legitimacy of fears and the need to exercise an abundance of caution in order to minimize the risk of infection and to save lives. At the same time, we recognize the need to exercise our faith and to act in a way consistent with calm attentiveness to prudence, public health and prayer.

With the above in mind, the following have been implemented:

- Until further notice, the Bishop hereby dispenses from the obligation to attend in Mass on Sundays and Holy Days of Obligation for all the faithful of the Diocese of Santa Rosa. Those faithful who wish to avoid crowded areas, out of legitimate concern for their health and/or the health of others, are encouraged to take advantage of this dispensation.
- The church is to be sanitized on a regular basis with even greater care than usual.
- Holy water is to be removed from fonts and the baptistery is either to be emptied or covered so that the faithful will not have access to water inside of it.
- The faithful are to receive Holy Communion on the hand for now, due to concern about distribution on

the tongue, in the light of serious risk of transmission.

- Communion from the cup is to be discontinued until further notice.
- All ministers of Holy Communion must sanitize their hands before and after Communion.

Respuesta al Coronavirus

En respuesta a la crisis que rodea el Coronavirus, reconocemos la legitimidad de los temores y la necesidad de ejercer una abundancia de precaución para minimizar el riesgo de infección y salvar vidas. Al mismo tiempo, reconocemos la necesidad de ejercer nuestra fe y de actuar de manera coherente con la mente tranquila y con prudencia a la salud pública.

Teniendo en cuenta lo anterior, se han implementado las siguientes cosas:

- Hasta nuevo aviso, el Obispo no obliga la asistencia a Misa los domingos y días de precepto a los fieles de la Diócesis de Santa Rosa. Se le alienta a aquellos fieles que deseen evitar las zonas concurridas, por legítima preocupación por su salud y/o la de los demás
- La iglesia debe ser desinfectada regularmente con aún más cuidado de lo habitual.
- La agua bendita debe ser eliminada de las fuentes y del baptisterio o por lo menos cubiertos para que los fieles no tengan acceso al agua.
- Los fieles recibirán la Santa Comunión en la mano por ahora, debido a la preocupación por la distribución en la lengua, a la luz del grave riesgo de transmisión.
- El Cáliz no se debe usar hasta nuevo aviso.
- Todos los ministros de la Santa Comunión deben desinfectar sus manos antes y después de la Comunión.
