Children's Liturgy of Word

Beginning Sunday, February 2nd, there will be a Children's Liturgy of the Word during the 9:00 AM Mass every Sunday. Children ages 4 through 8 years old will be invited to accompany two adult volunteers to break open the Word of the Lord in an age-appropriate manner. Children will adjourn to the baptismal chapel just before the first reading and return to sit with their parents following the Prayers of the Faithful. "Children Celebrate!" from Pflaum Publishers is the curriculum that will be used. The adult volunteers are parents from St. Rose School who are providing this ministry in hopes of making Mass more meaningful and prayerful for all. Volunteers have been cleared by the diocesan Safe Environment Program.
